## RE: SEVENTY-THIRD WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees and Family Members,

We regret to inform you that two employees who have recently worked on Norton 1 & Norton 2, as well as Shaw/Manning 1 & 2, have tested positive for COVID-19. Yesterday, all residents and employees having worked on Norton 1 were tested for COVID-19 and residents and employees who have worked on Norton 2 and Shaw/Manning 1 & 2 will be tested tomorrow morning. Please note that residents under preventive isolation must be quarantined in their room until they receive their COVID-19 results. One PRIMARY CAREGIVER per resident is authorized to visit per day until preventive measures are lifted.

We have all hoped that the pandemic would have been under control by now but that has clearly not been the case. Our province is experiencing a rapid increase in COVID-19 cases. This trend is expected to continue over the coming weeks as a result of the highly transmissible Omicron variant. Based on recommendations from Public Health, increased restrictions are immediately being placed in CHSLDs and senior residences to reduce the risk of the virus entering the facility (see attached grid, updates highlighted). These temporary enhanced and responsive measures are necessary to provide optimal safety and support to residents, while balancing the mental and emotional well-being of residents and their families, and to safeguard the staff who are critical to the care of our residents.

## Immediate changes include:

- Residents are permitted four (4) visitors per day and only one (1) visitor at a time. Visitors must always wear their mask and must distance themselves 2-metres from residents and employees. Visitors are not permitted in common areas unless they are assisting a resident during mealtime.
- Residents living in the CHSLD and Central: Any resident who goes on an outing other than a medical appointment, upon return must be tested for Covid-19 and isolated until we receive the results.
- The third dose of the COVID vaccine is now accessible to health care workers 3 months after their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose instead of the original 6 months announced by the MSSS.

We understand how difficult these measures will be for our residents and their loved ones. Please understand that our employees do not have control over the virus or over the measures put in place by our government to keep our health system from being overwhelmed. Our employees are equally frustrated and disappointed.

Directives applicable to the Wales Home and CHSLD Wales		
Visitation		
Visiting Hours	<ul> <li>Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., 12:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., and 5:45 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.</li> <li>Friday to Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., 12:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.</li> <li>Hours do not change on statutory holidays.</li> <li>The Visit Coordinator must be at their desk when visitors sign in and out. If the visit coordinator is on break, visitors must wait for her to return. Break times are:  → 10:00 − 10:15, 3:00 − 3:15 and on Thursdays: 5 − 5:45</li> <li>If visitors are helping during mealtime, they must wait for the Visit Coordinator's return prior to leaving the building.</li> <li>Visitors must leave the building BEFORE the end of visiting hours (prior 5:00 p.m. or 8:00 p.m. on Thursdays).</li> </ul>	
Visiting Pets	Permitted	
Visits inside the building in common areas, including the dining rooms, hallways and living rooms	<ul> <li>NOT PERMITTED</li> <li>An exception can be made in the dining room if the visitor is assisting a resident during mealtime.</li> </ul>	

Visits inside the resident's room	<ul> <li>Permitted with the following directives: <ul> <li>1 visitor at a time, for a maximum of 4 visitors per day.</li> <li>The visitor must provide their Vaxicode and/or vaccine passport to the visit coordinator.</li> <li>A visitor that cannot provide their vaccine passport must present proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR or TAAN test result completed within the last 72 hours.</li> <li>Visitors must respect a 2-metre distance.</li> <li>All visitors aged 2 or over are obliged to wear a mask inside.</li> </ul> </li></ul>
Visits to a resident on isolation and/or on a unit with an outbreak	<ul> <li>Permitted with the following directives:         <ul> <li>A maximum of 4 primary caregivers must be identified for the resident, and only 1 primary caregiver will be authorized to visit the resident per day.</li> <li>Prior to visiting, the primary caregiver will have to be trained on the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). An appointment must be taken through Health Services</li></ul></li></ul>

	<ul> <li>A visitor that cannot provide their vaccine passport must present proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR or TAAN test result completed within the last 72 hours.</li> <li>Visitors must respect social distancing (2-meters) at all times, as well as wear their procedural mask at all times.</li> </ul>

Outings to a restaurant and/or a private residence INSIDE OR OUTSIDE <mark>(regardless of length of time)</mark>	<ul> <li>Permitted with the following directives:         <ul> <li>Upon return, residents on Norton 1, 2, 3 and Central will need to undergo a COVID test and will be isolated until results are received.</li> <li>Residents living on Manning/Shaw are required to monitor their symptoms daily for 14 days following their return. Meals in the dining room	<ul> <li>Permitted with the following directives:</li> <li>Residents must wear their mask, maintain a 2-metre distance, and avoid large groups in the elevator when going to the dining room.</li> <li>Maximum of 4 residents per table.</li> <li>Masks can be removed only once seated.</li> <li>1-metre distance between each table</li> </ul>

Cinema room	PERMITTED     Residents must wear their mask and maintain a 2-metre distance from others.
Billiards room	<ul> <li>PERMITTED</li> <li>Residents must wear their mask and maintain a 2-metre distance from others.</li> <li>Disinfect objects after each use.</li> </ul>
Spiritual Services	PERMITTED     Residents must wear their mask and maintain a 2-metre distance from others.
