RE: NINETY-NINETH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees and Family Members,

For the second time this week, the government has changed the regulations regarding visitations.

Effective Saturday, February 12th:

- **Both Primary Caregivers and Visitors** 13 years + who have proof of 2 vaccines (QR code) are authorized to visit residents in both the RPA and CHSLD Wales Inc.
- Any visitor who tested positive for COVID-19 cannot visit for at least 10 days of the date of onset of symptoms
- All visitors must respect measures of wearing a mask, visor and **always** distancing themselves 2metres from the resident. Visitors cannot remove their mask to drink or eat during visit
- Visiting in common areas is **forbidden** e.g., walking in hallway, or visiting in the solarium. <u>Visitations are in the resident's bedroom/apartment only</u>
- Anyone not respecting the regulations will have their visitation rights suspended
- Outings for residents living in the CHSLD are now permitted
