## RE: ONE HUNDREDTH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees, and Family Members,

Québec is moving forward with a step-by-step easing of Public Health measures over the coming weeks and months as we transition out of a state of emergency and learn to live with COVID-19. Recently, our Minister of Health shared critical information regarding restrictions being lifted in a three-stage timeline. Below I highlight the phases that directly affect Wales visitations:

## • Effective this past Monday, February 21st, 2022:

- o RPA residents may welcome a maximum of ten visitors per day
- o Their visitors are now permitted in common areas and there are no restrictions on the number of visitors at a time

## • Effective on Monday, February 28th, 2022:

- o CHSLD residents may welcome a maximum of ten visitors per day
- Their visitors *will be* permitted in common areas and there will be no restrictions on the number of visitors at a time

## • Effective on Monday, March 14th, 2022:

- o Vaccination proof and registration at Door Number One will no longer be mandatory
- o There will be no more designated visiting hours

As we phase out certain measures, please ensure you follow the below safety standards:

- Washing and sanitizing your hands continues to be one of the most effective ways to mitigate risks
- Self-isolation rules persist if you have COVID-19
- Masking is required for employees and visitors
- Please stay home when you are sick

We respect that some families and employees feel uneasy about how quickly the restrictions are being lifted; we too have concerns. We ask that visitors respect the measures in place, including keeping your mask on for the entirety of your visit. Anyone not respecting the regulations will have their visitation rights suspended.

Let us continue to work together to maintain our safety and wellbeing. We do not know what the next few months may bring, however, I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your unwavering support and commitment to the Wales when we truly need you most.

If the Visit Coordinator is on break, visitors must wait for their return.
