Since Sunday, April 3rd, 2022, thirty-eight out of our 167 active employees tested positive for the virus, equalling twenty-three percent of our workforce and 190 shifts to fill. As of today, thirty-seven of these employees returned to work, equalling ninety-seven percent and 185 shifts restored. We therefore have one active employee out of 167 out sick with COVID-19, equalling 0.5 percent of our workforce and five shifts to replace. Please see the updated general guidelines below.
