Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

There have been no new COVID-19 cases at the Wales since our last update. Effective tomorrow, RPA residents no longer need to wear masks in common areas, *unless* a CHSLD resident is in the same room. Please see the table below for examples:

Is masking necessary when	RPA Residents	CHSLD Residents
I visit my neighbour?	No	
I go to the Main Dining Room?	No	
I go outside?	No	Once outside, masks can be removed
I attend activities in the Main Living Room?	If CHSLD residents are present, then yes	
I bike in the Therapy Room?		
I attend Friday Tea in the Main Dining Room?		
I visit a resident in the opposite entity?	Yes	

Effective immediately, employees no longer need to register upon their arrival at work.

## **Directives Applicable to the Wales**

Visitors			
Masks must be worn upon entry			
<ul> <li>Please wash your hands and apply the clean procedural mask supplied by the Wales</li> </ul>			
<ul> <li>Masks must <i>not</i> be removed or lowered during your visit</li> </ul>			
<ul> <li>Each resident may host a maximum of ten visitors per day</li> </ul>			
CHSLD visitors  Registration at Door Numb mandatory			
Visits to a resident under self-isolation or a unit in an outbreak	Permitted; a maximum of <i>four</i> primary caregivers must be identified per resident and only <i>one</i> may visit per day, although they can visit multiple times per day. Each primary caregiver must be trained on proper personal protective equipment application

	RPA	CHSLD	
Masking as of Saturday, May 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2022	Not mandatory unless in a common area with a CHSLD resident	Not mandatory on the unit, but masks must be worn once off the unit	
Private services in the residents' apartment, suite, or room	Service provider must wear a mask
