REGARDING: 125TH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

There have been no new COVID-19 cases at the Wales since the last update. One resident is still self-isolating; however, this measure will be lifted tomorrow. According to Public Health, the Wales remains in an outbreak until Tuesday, May 10th, 2022. Employees must continue wearing N95 masks until Public Health advises otherwise.

Visitation is authorized for both primary caregivers and visitors in residents' apartments, suites, or rooms *only* while respecting physical distancing and wearing a mask; no other personal protective equipment is required. Visitors are <u>not</u> permitted in common areas until further notice. Visitors may go outside with residents, but they must keep their mask on, therefore eating and drinking are not permitted during the visit. CHSLD visitors must register at Door Number One. Regardless of entity, visitors must:

- Wash their hands and apply a clean mask supplied by the Wales
- Ensure a maximum of ten visitors per resident per day
- Respect physical distancing
- Not enter common areas until further notice, unless assisting during mealtime

I would like to wish our mothers a Happy Mother's Day. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation with sanitary measures.
