Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

For two days, there have been no new covid cases on Central. To date, 6/12 residents living on Central tested positive for COVID-19. Any family member who is visiting someone who is positive with COVID-19, must wear personal protective equipment during visits. The outbreak is in place for a minimum of 10 days as of the last positive case.

An employee working on Norton 3 tested positive for COVID-19 on November 22nd.

This is a friendly reminder that all visitors must always wear their masks during visits. With the holiday season quickly approaching, we have taken the decision that the mask mandate will continue into 2024, therefore visitors will not be permitted to eat meals in our dining rooms. We apologize in advance for the inconvenience, we are doing everything possible to keep your family, our residents, and employees safe.
