RE: NINETY-FIFTH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees and Family Members,

Good news!!!!! Results are in and EVERY resident is NEGATIVE for COVID-19! 49/50 employees received negative results; one result is still pending. We will immediately lift all isolations except for any resident showing cold/flu-like symptoms according to our standing policy. Currently there are only two residents in the RPA showing cold symptoms. Yesterday, an LPN tested positive for Covid-19 and Public Health was advised. Residents who were on isolation must have their symptoms monitored until January 24th inclusive.

All residents will resume their regular activities while respecting the 2-metre distancing and wearing a mask. Residents from Shaw/Manning 1 and 4th floor will resume eating in the living room effective noon tomorrow and residents from Shaw/Manning 2 will return to the dining room with the apartment residents.

Employees providing <u>close care/services</u> must continue to wear an N95 and visor until further notice. The entire building is now considered a Cold zone, therefore one N95 mask per shift unless soiled/wet.
