REGARDING: 159TH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

Since our last update, one Manning 2 resident, one Norton 2 resident, and one Shaw 2 resident tested positive for COVID-19 and are therefore self-isolating to their rooms for ten days. RPA residents who are not on isolation returned to the Main Dining Room for their meals as of today, as there is a sufficient number of residents who are no longer quarantined. The table below depicts our current COVID-19 situation:

Norton 3	0/32 = 0%	No
Shaw 3	5/12 = 42%	Yes
Shaw 4 and the Mitchell Suites	2/10 = 20%	Yes
Total	28/195 = 14%	Six units under outbreak

^{*}I spoke with Public Health today and they confirmed that Norton 1's outbreak will be lifted today.

Two employees are currently out sick due to the virus, constituting ten missing shifts per week. Employees will closely monitor residents to reduce deconditioning, including maintaining scheduled bathing, supervised walks in hallways with proper personal protective equipment, and individualized visits from the Activity Department in their rooms.
