## REGARDING: 124TH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

There have been no new COVID-19 cases at the Wales since last week. Only one RPA resident and one CHSLD resident remain on self-isolation, however they should both be completed by the end of this week.

According to Public Health, the Wales remains in an outbreak until we go fourteen days without a new positive case among our residents *and* employees. If there are no new cases, our outbreak status will be removed on Tuesday, May  $10^{th}$ , 2022.

Visitation is authorized for both primary caregivers and visitors in residents' apartments, suites, or rooms *only* while respecting physical distancing and wearing a mask; no other personal protective equipment is required. We must remain extra vigilant until our outbreak status is dismissed, therefore visitors are not permitted in common areas until further notice. For the two residents still under self-isolation, only their four designated primary caregivers may visit until their isolations are lifted. If there are no changes, the next COVID-19 update will be issued on Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation with sanitary measures. I appreciate your efforts to help us protect our residents and employees from this deadly virus.
