Directives Applicable to the Wales

Visitors	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks must be worn upon entry • Please wash your hands and apply the clean procedural mask provided by the Wales <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks may <i>not</i> be removed or lowered during your visit • Each resident may host ten visitors per day <i>maximum</i> 	
CHSLD Visitors	Registration at Door Number One is mandatory
Visits to a resident under self-isolation or a unit under outbreak	Permitted; four primary caregivers must be appointed for each resident and only they may visit. Only one primary caregiver may visit per day, however this individual can visit multiple times in the same day. Primary caregivers must be trained on proper personal protective equipment application.
