REGARDING: 117TH WALES COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

Today, two employees who share a household tested positive for COVID-19. Both Norton 1 and Norton 2 are on reverse isolation due to their number of positive cases, meaning negative residents are self-isolating in their rooms and positive residents are free to roam throughout the unit; this arrangement facilitates supervision. An infection control nurse will be onsite on Friday, April 22nd, 2022 to plan a tentative date for lifting self-isolations and other restrictions. Please see the table below for resident positivity since Sunday, April 3rd, 2022:
