Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

Although the numbers have significantly decreased, we continue to have employees and residents infected with COVID-19 symptoms. Family members can still visit a resident in isolation but must comply with the personal protection measures in place. Public Health has recommended that residents in isolation who are scheduled for a bath receive a bed bath instead of bathing in the common whirlpool room.
