Dear Residents, Employees, Family Members, and Volunteers,

This morning, four residents on Central tested positive for COVID-19. Public health has declared the unit in an outbreak. Those who tested positive are isolated in their rooms; visitors must wear personal protective equipment during visits. Residents who are not infected can attend activities on the unit. The outbreak is in place for a minimum of 10 days.
